#### California: unknown

There are <u>no requirements</u> by California to <u>report</u> abortion data, but reports on taxpayer-funded abortions via Medi-Cal for <u>2014</u> reveal that 4438 Dilation and Evacuation (<u>D+E</u>) abortions were paid for by the state. In <u>2014</u>, Guttmacher, the former "<u>special affiliate</u>" of Planned Parenthood, <u>reported</u> 157,350 abortions in California. The data does not break these abortions down by gestation.

### Colorado: at least 10 percent

The state openly admits that <u>published</u> abortion numbers are "believed to be significantly underestimated." Out of the 8,873 abortions reported in <u>2017</u>, 855 were committed at 13 weeks and up: 376 (13-15 weeks), 194 (16-21 weeks), and 285 (21 and greater). These numbers are expected to be much lower than what is taking place in the state, especially later in pregnancy.

Reporting instructions ask for the number of weeks since patient's last menstrual period. If this information is unavailable, reporters are asked to substitute a clinical estimate of gestation. It is not known which reports used which measure, nor the proportion of reports using each. A physician's estimate of gestational age based on clinical observation is generally more reliable and may be several weeks less than the patient's reported weeks since last menstrual period. Readers should be aware of the imprecision in the measure. The table groups the reported weeks into categories used by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Alan Guttmacher institute.
